Make every effort to attend one of these presentations. These are the only dates that this Internship Orientation will be given for Cohort 46. This will be counted towards the seven seminars you are REQUIRED to attend. If you are not able to attend your location please call 516-221-2936 and notify the office of the location you wish to attend (call only if you are switching).

To fulfill the registration, you need to bring with you a check, cash, money order or credit card for \$950 or \$1900 (made out to CITE) to be handed in at the orientation. This will pay for EDA 546 (\$950) or EDA 546 & 547 (\$1900). Please be ON TIME and prepared to pay for, at least, the first half of your internship. If you are not prepared to pay at this time, you must pay by January 1st, 2016 or you will not be able to begin your internship.

Recent Change Announced on NYSED website:

School District Leader: Candidates who apply for professional School District Leader certification on or after May 1, 2015 must pass the Educating All Students examination.

Previously this was only true for the SBL certification. If you did not have to take it for your SBL and are now applying for SDL on or after May 1, 2015 you will need to take the EAS exam, as well as the SDL Exams. CITE offers Test Prep for the EAS exam at no cost for our students. The information can be found on page three of this newsletter.

The next administration of the SBL NYSED certification assessments will take place February 13th - February 19th (Test 107/108) and the SDL NYSED certifications will take place February 23rd - March 4th (Test 103/104) in a revised on-line format. To register to take the exams go to www.nystce.nesinc.com. Our analysis of assessment results to date, in combination with feedback from our students who successfully completed those assessments, has resulted in our strong recommendation that all students taking the August SBL and SDL assessments fully access the on line Test Prep resources referenced below prior to taking the tests.

All students must attend at least one Test Prep seminar. We strongly recommend participation in Test Prep sessions. There is no charge for these sessions. Completion of all SBL and SDL courses is recommended before taking the SDL assessment. Whenever possible, we encourage all students to take Parts One and Two of each assessment on different days.

Students must enroll by emailing barbara@citeonline.com or contacting the CITE office @ 516-221-2936 at least two weeks in advance of the first session.

A minimum enrollment of 10 students is required for the sessions to be offered. The Test Prep sessions will include: highlights of relevant coursework concepts. Use the SBL and SDL New York State Certification Examinations Preparation Guides in constructing narrative responses to content specific issues. You can only attend Test Prep after attending Internship Orientation.

To actively participate in the course or independently engage in self study students need to download and bring to test prep sessions the SBL/SDL NYSTCE Preparation Guides (www.nystce.nesinc.com).

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
